The Microscopy Society of America (MSA) is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to the promotion and advancement of the knowledge of the science and practice of all microscopical imaging, analysis and diffraction techniques useful for elucidating the nanostructure and function of materials in diverse areas of biological, materials, medical and physical sciences. MSA has been the resource for nanostructural analysis and nanocharacterization since 1942.

Currently, there are about 3,000 members worldwide, including nearly 400 student members. The membership reflects a healthy interdisciplinary balance among all aspects of the field—in particular, techniques, research, applications, and instrumentation. The Society is especially interested in encouraging the activities of young scientists, and offers scholarships, travel grants, and reduced annual and conference registration fees for student members. The Society holds its annual meeting, Microscopy & Microanalysis, a major international scientific conference that includes the premier commercial exhibition showcasing new instrumentation and technique advancements. Members receive—at no additional charge—subscriptions to the MSA scientific journal, *Microscopy and Microanalysis*, and the MSA bimonthly periodical, *Microscopy Today*. Other benefits include access to the MSA Placement Office, the MSA Certification Board, and a wide variety of educational resources (courses, DVD lectures). Members are welcome to join Focused Interest Groups, which were designed to facilitate technical discussion and activities in specific areas of interest to members. The Society represents the profession in public affairs, and serves as a center for education and information dissemination for microscopy-related knowledge. In addition, many meetings and activities are organized throughout the U.S. by the 30 Local Affiliate Societies.
